This email is being sent on behalf of NYSA President, Guy Hobbs.

As you are all aware, the current suspension of soccer-related activities was placed in force through May 15. Since putting that suspension in place, we have continued to monitor data and guidance from the CDC, Federal, state and local authorities, peer groups, other amateur sports organizations, and other credible and relevant sources.

It is clear at this time that the current social distancing protocols and state of the virus containment effort will not allow for us to resume activities by May 15. While we understand this news may be frustrating to many, we are confident that you share in our belief that ensuring the safety and well-being of our members is our key responsibility. Circulated to you earlier today is our initial "return to play" plan, broken into four key phases., which we will use to resume activities once it appears prudent to do so. As such, there are no dates currently assigned to the four phases of our start-up plan. Dates will be assigned to these phases once we are confident that resuming activities is a safe and responsible course. While we expect that we will be initiating the return to play plans in the coming weeks, we remain under an indefinite suspension of all soccer-related activities until further notice. We will provide updates as additional information becomes available.
